

MERIDIANS is a new European network, created by 6 major European performing arts festivals, for the exchange of artists, joint creation and intercultural dialogue in the performing arts in non-conventional venues.

The network will promote the creation and co-production of works based on exchanges between artists and/or partners from various European Union countries, in order to spread intercultural and European creations in the field of the performing arts that inhabit and use the city as a stage and enclave to link the citizens to the new street and non-conventional theatre languages.

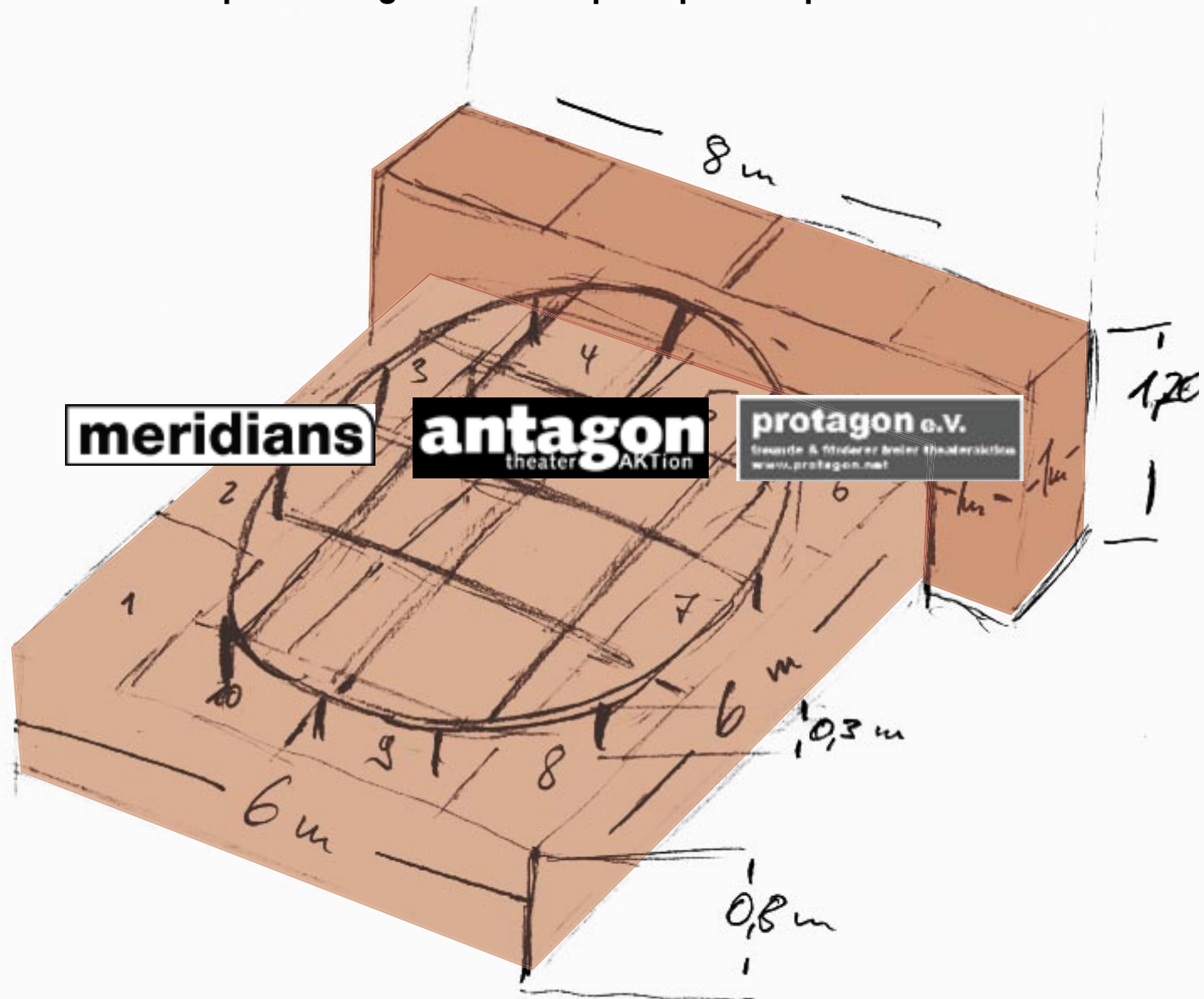
MERIDIANS aims to promote exchange and mobility of artists for the creation of a joint work. Interculturality will be both the theme that inspires the creation and the origins, and focus for the artists.

There will be the maximum diffusion of the new works commissioned by the network with the support of the EU Culture programme.
